Troop 360 Electronic Devices Policy

Troop meetings

Cell phones can only be used at the end of the meeting, except for emergencies.

Computers, tablets, MP3 players, hand held games etc. are not needed, and should not be there.

Consequences; First offence – Confiscate device, no game, song at closing to get it back. Second offense – Confiscate device, phone returned to a parent after the meeting.

Troop outings

Your phone may be used as a timepiece.

May be used for emergencies.

Used to call home at the end of the outing.

Computers, tablets, MP3 players, etc. are not needed, and should not be there.

Consequences; Confiscate device and return it to a parent at the end of the outing.

Troop campouts

Upon arriving for a campout, surrender your phone to an adult leader who will place it in in a lock box for storage.

Upon request, at leader discretion, your phone may be returned to make and important call.

There will be phone time in the evenings from 9:00-9:30.

Your phone will be returned at the conclusion of the outing.

We will attempt to leave a leader's cell number with a parent for contact in an emergency.

Computers, tablets, MP3 players, etc. are not needed, and should not be there.

Consequences; Confiscate device and return it to a parent at the end of the outing.

Long bus trips

MP3 players with ear buds may be used while on the bus, and put away when off the bus. These should not be left on the bus, for security reasons. The MP3 player should not be used when off the bus. Consequences; Confiscate device and return it to a parent at the end of the outing.
